- C. Applications for this award for the <u>2020-2021</u> school year must be on this form only, filled out in its entirety, signed and mailed to the above address between May 1 and June 1, <u>2020</u>. Your application will be ineligible if dated other than between May 1 and June 1, <u>2020</u>. Applications must contain original signatures on page 3 (not copies) and **all information must be current as of date of mailing**. Applications that do not conform to this requirement will not be considered. In the interest of legibility, we encourage you to use the bank's online PDF editor at bankprospect.com/community/scholarships/.
- D. An *official transcript* of <u>ALL</u> college and university grades through the <u>2019-2020</u> school year <u>must</u> accompany this application. However, if an official transcript of your <u>2020</u> spring semester grades is not available at the time you make this application, you are then <u>required</u> to submit a spring grade report or internet grade report *in addition to your official transcript*. If the transcript requirement is not complete, your application will not be considered.
